Dear Parent/Carer,



## **Student Information Sheet: Remote Access and My Teams**

#### **Remote Access to Shared Areas**

A link to access the shared area from home is now available on the school website:

This screen will then open:




Log in using your school email address and password.

Once logged on this screen will appear:



You should be able to see Microsoft Office alongside a folder entitled 'explorer'.

To access the **school network**. Click on explorer.



This popup will appear:


You may need to add TORCHACADEMY\ to your username if it hasn't already been prepopulated.

Then log in with your normal password and you should be able to access the school network - both your area and the student shared area.

# **Microsoft Teams**

To connect to Microsoft Teams follow the instructions below:

1. Click on the envelope icon on the NUSA website (www.nusa.org.uk):




2. The Microsoft Office page will open and you will be able to see all the Microsoft software available for you to use at home. To access Teams simply click on the icon that says Teams.





- 3. You will then be able to see all the 'teams' (classes) that you have been added to. Similar to the picture below; however, you will see all of your subjects. They are named NUSA followed by the year group, then the subject (i.e. Ch = Chemistry, CS = Computer Science) and finally the academic year. If you have a class missing please email you class teacher to get them to add you to the group or activate the class.
- 4. To access a Team simply click on that class and it will take you to the page below which shows the general post board for the class:

This shows you any general posts (i.e. messages from your class teacher). It will also show any assignments that have been set.

5. To complete the assignment either click on the assignment on the main post page, or alternatively click on the assignment tab and then open the assignment you want to complete. An assignment could be an online quiz or alternatively there may be a task which requires you to upload your response.









When you have completed the online quiz simply click submit and you class teacher will be able to see and mark your submission.



Alternatively for an assignment you may be given a written task to complete. The example to the left requires the students to complete the attached exam questions. There is a link to a video to help complete the questions.

6. Once completed you upload your file/s and click 'Turn in'. This will then allow your class teacher to see and mark your work.





When you open an assignment or quiz in Teams you may see the button below:

Immersive Reader

If you click on this icon it will provide additional assistance to allow you to access the text. You can:

- Get the software to read aloud the text
- Change the size of the font and line spacing
- Change the background colour
- Change the language if your first language is not English.
