I wanted to write to you to outline end of terms plans and arrangements for celebrating Christmas within school.

At NUSA, we love to run end of term rewards trips for all students. Due to the current situation with Covid, we are not able to run any trips. However, we feel it is really important that we give all of the students the recognition they deserve this half term and allow them to celebrate the end of term with their friends.

Therefore, we will be running a 'Rewards day' for each year group in the final week of term as follows:
