FAO: PARENTS OF CHILDREN IN RECEIPT OF FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Dear Parent/Carer,

Following our unfortunate closure yesterday due to staff shortage, we have been working today on a way of providing our families who have access to Free School Meals with some form of provision.

The voucher scheme that was put in place by the Government came to an end in the Summer holidays. As a result, we have had to seek an alternative offer to cover next week.

Our catering company Aspens have been able to offer us the provision of food parcels which can be collected from school. We are grateful for this as there is currently no provision offered by the Government for this unfortunate scenario.

Am I entitled to a food parcel?

You will be entitled to collect a food parcel if your child is in Year 7, Year 8 or Year 9 and in receipt of free school meals.

How do I sign up for the parcel?

Please complete the link on our main school web page by 12pm on Thursday 15th October. Entries after this date and time cannot be catered for – www.nusa.org.uk

Once I have signed up, what happens next?

Food parcels will be available to collect from the double doors at the front of our school on Monday 19th October between 10am and 11am. No collections will be available after this time.

What if I cannot make the collection on Monday 19th October between 10am and 11am?

If you are struggling to make this time or find yourself in the position whereby you need to isolate, please contact school reception by Friday 16th October to allow us to arrange an alternative method of collection.
