Industrial Action:

I wrote to you earlier in the week with the promise of plans for Wednesday 1st February being sent out today. Please find below the plans for the day. Please note, these plans are for this day only and plans regarding future strike days will be sent out closer to the time.

Students who will be expected in school on Wednesday 1st February 2023 – Year 7/Year 11/Year13

Students who will not be in school on Wednesday 1st February 2023 – Year 8/Year 9/Year 10/Year 12

This is not a decision I have taken lightly, but due to the number of staff proposed to be absent on the day, I have to ensure that we have enough staff in school to keep the children safe.

If further strike days do occur, the Year groups will change each time so that the same students are not impacted every time.
