## The information below on mask wearing and uniform was included in my previous letter.

## Mask wearing

On our return to school, all students will be expected to wear masks at all times, except in PE lessons and when outdoors. Therefore, your child will need to come to school with a mask each day. Where a child forgets a mask, we will issue a new disposable one and will make a note on their Bromcom. If your child is exempt from mask wearing, they will have previously been issued with an exemption card. We will, however, reissue these in case they have been lost.

If your child refuses to wear a mask, and does not have an exemption card, we will follow our normal school behavior policy in terms of consequences.
