Dear Parents/Carers,

We have been so impressed with the students calm and settled return to school over the past two weeks. We have gone straight back in to learning and the students have responded really well to this. Many of your children will have come home with positive 'Green Flag' postcards or will have reported how well they have been getting on with their work. Considering all they have faced over the past year, we are incredibly proud of their resilience.

Behaviour procedures

Please find attached to this letter a reminder of the steps for our behaviour system. We do not shy away from the fact that we are strict at school and have the highest expectations of all of the students. Where a student has to be removed from a lesson, it is as a result of them not meeting our expectations and this would consequently impact the learning of others in the room. No child should come to school and have learning time taken from them as a result of another child's poor choices. I thank you all for your continued support with our behaviour systems as it really does make a difference.

Equipment expectations

We expect all students to attend school with a pen, pencil and ruler. These are essential equipment items to enable students to participate in learning fully. Each morning we have an equipment trolley outside of school which students can purchase pens, pencils and rulers for 20 Bromcom points. If a student fails to equip themselves appropriately before school, we will then give them equipment during lesson time but this will result in a deduction of 100 Bromcom points.

School Dinners

From Monday 19th March 2021, students will be able to purchase school dinners again. Students will have a pin number to use in the short term instead of fingerprints. The pin numbers have been issued to students today. If a student forgets their pin, they can ask reception for a reminder.

Free school meals over the Easter holiday period

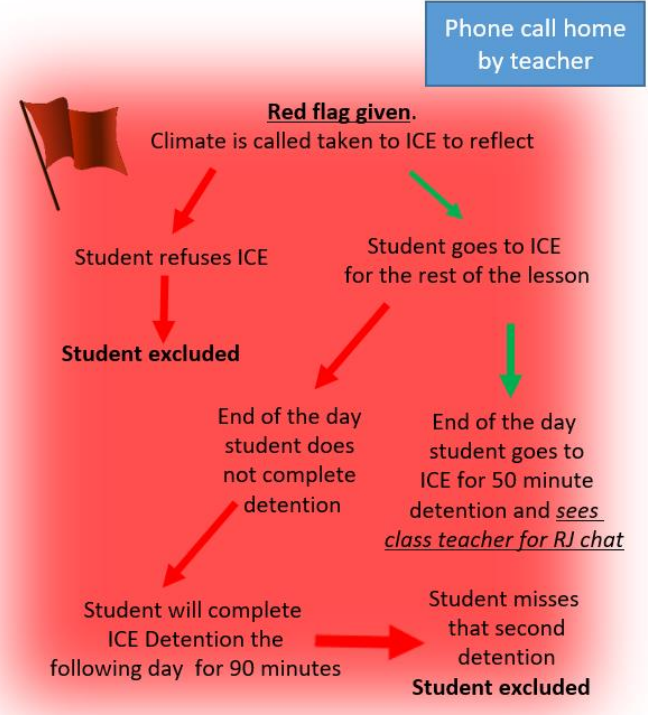


Disrupt learning, affecting learning of others.
