Dear Parent/Carer,

I hope that you are all keeping well.

It has been so lovely to see so many Year 10 students in school for their one-to-one appointments. I will be writing to Year 10 parents separately on Tuesday 23rd June with additional information regarding return to school from Monday 29th June. All subject appointment times for the week commencing 22nd June have been sent via email to all Year 10 students.

I received some exciting news from the DfE this week to indicate that we may be able to have a face-to-face session with Year 7, Year 8 and Year 9 before the end of term. We are currently looking in to plans of how we could facilitate this and will get in touch with parents next week with our proposals.

We are excited to host a series of 'live' events next week for Year 7 to Year 10. This will provide them with the opportunity to join a Teams meeting online with their peers, myself and their Head of Year. Key worker and vulnerable students

We will continue to offer provision for children of Key Workers and vulnerable students. This provision is limited in number due to current staffing levels and as a result, if we see an increase in demand for this provision, we may have to make amendments to timings/days. Our current provision runs from 9am until 2pm each day. During this time, a teacher supervises whilst each student works independently on the work that has been set for them on TEAMS.
