Dear parents/carers,

We are approaching the end of the exam season, and students have conducted themselves extremely well and have been excellent at attending the pre-exam warm-up sessions run by staff.

From Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> June all students will be on study leave and therefore only need to attend school for warmups and exams, they will be in to sit their Chemistry paper at 8:40am on this day (warm up from 8am) and then they will be allowed to go straight home. If you do not wish your child to have study leave (i.e. you want them to continue to come in to school each day after Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> June), please contact us.

While on study leave it is vital that students still arrive in plenty of time for their exams:

**AM exams start at 9am, this means students need to be lined up in school no later than 8:45am.**

**PM exams start at 1:30pm, this means students must be in by 1:15pm.**

As of next week students in Year 11 also no longer need to attend in school uniform. If they have any items of uniform or PE kit that could be donated to support our lower years, it would be much appreciated. Please drop it at reception on Monday or Tuesday.

If your child has a locker, please ask them to return their key to Jo Thomas in order to get their deposit returned.

On Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> June there will be a shirt signing event for students between 9:30am and 10:30am, all Year 11 students are welcome to attend, there will be refreshments and an opportunity to celebrate their time together as well as the all-important shirt signing.
